Where to Find Hungarian Pastries and Punk in Morningside Heights

Welcome to *Drinks, Dinner, and Dessert*, in which we share three picks in one neighborhood, keeping an eye out for deals, off-the-menu items, and new stuff to check out. This week, get off the 1 train at 110th Street and use these suggestions to guide you through Morningside Heights.

Dinner: Amigos

Amigos is the month-old pop-up Mexican restaurant from Chef Alex Garcia of <u>A.G. Kitchen</u> that has already garnered a neighborhood following. Garcia's burgers are topped with bacon, cheddar, and guacamole, and served with spicy "Mexican" fries for \$13. The queso fundido mixed with mushrooms and red peppers pulls apart easily and is served piping-hot with warm tortillas for \$9. If you're with a group, order the 32-ounce Fish Bowl -- near-lethal pineapple rum punch -- for \$19. But if you're dipping into beach drinks, you might as well order a \$10 "Shark Attack," a mixture of vodka, lemonade, and grenadine, which comes with a toy shark. *2888 Broadway*
